CLOTHING:

- 1 Complete Set of Clothing Per Day + At Least 2 Extra Sets of Clothing
- 1 Pair of Jeans/Pants
- 1 Long-Sleeved Shirts or Light Jacket/Sweatshirt
- Undergarments & Socks for Each Day + At Least 2 Extra Sets
- Closed Toe, Closed Heel Shoes (Required for Some Activities)
- Water Shoes with Heel/Heel Strap
- Extra Pair of Shoes, if Possible
- Flip Flops (For Showering Only)
- 2-3 Swimsuits (Modest, One Piece Swimsuits are Required)
- Raincoat/Poncho (No Umbrellas)
- Pajamas for Each Night

BEDDING:

- Twin Sheet Set or Sleeping Bag* + Fitted Sheet
 - Pillow & Pillowcase
 - Extra Blanket
- *Navajo and Seminole need sleeping bags for campout

TOILETRIES:

- Comb/Brush
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Soap/Body Wash
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- 1-2 Bath Towels
- Washcloths/Loofah
- Deodorant, If Needed
- Feminine Hygiene Products, If Needed

Parents/Guardians: We highly recommend that you involve your camper in the packing process! This helps to ensure that they are able to re-pack their bags independently at the end of the week. We encourage you to send only items that you do not mind getting dirty/lost and to label EVERYTHING.

MISCELLANEOUS:

- Bible
- Laundry Bag (No Hampers/Baskets)
- Bug Spray (NO AEROSOL)
- Sunscreen (NO AEROSOL)
- Flashlight + Extra Batteries
- 1-2 Beach Towels (thin towels dry faster)
- Water Bottle
- Clip-On Fan* (9" or Smaller)
*Personal fans are provided in the Chico huts, and we ask that Chicos do not bring their own.
- Letter Writing Supplies (Pre-Addressed & Stamped Envelopes Recommended for Young Campers)
- Medications, If Needed (KEEP THIS WITH YOU DURING CHECK IN)

OPTIONAL ITEMS:

- Camera/Film
- Puzzle Books, Mad Libs, Books, etc. for Rest Time
- Hat
- Small Backpack for Carrying Towel, Water Bottle, etc.
- Costumes for Night Activities

NIGHT ACTIVITIES:

- ✘ **Sunday • Opening Ceremonies**
Wear the hut color listed in your email one week prior to camp.
- ✘ **Monday • Mission Impossible**
Wear camouflage or dark colors.
- ✘ **Tuesday • Pirate Night**
Wear pirate attire, matey. (Campout for Navajos & Seminoles)
- ✘ **Wednesday • Campfire Night**
Camping Gear - bucket hat, cargo/khaki type shorts, PFG shirts, vests, etc.
- ✘ **Thursday • Holy Grail**
Wear a white t-shirt and white/khaki shorts.
- ✘ **Friday • Country Night**
Wear overalls, plaid, cowboy hats, etc. . . . attire for the farm.

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- Cell Phones/Smart Watches (Campers found with these devices will be sent home without a refund.)
- Footlockers/Trunks
- Large Fans
- Valuables/Electronics of Any Kind
- Over-the-Counter Medications
- Money
- Revealing Clothing (Girls - No halter/spaghetti straps, low cut tops, or two-piece swimsuits.)

- Clothing with inappropriate words, gestures, referencing drugs or alcohol
 - Fireworks, Knives, Weapons, etc.
 - Aerosol cans of any type (bug spray, sunscreen, spray paint, etc.)
